## SYMPOSIUM – “INFINITRON 2K25”

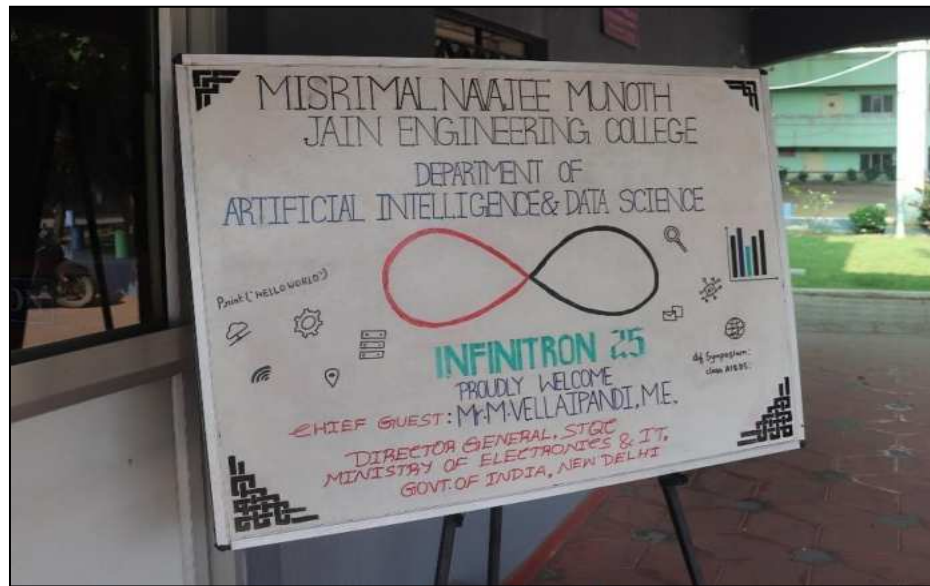
### REPORT
