1. Signing of MOU with Quality Circle Forum of India – Chennai Chapter

An MOU was signed on 19th September 2025 between The Quality Circle Forum of India (QCFI) - Chennai Chapter and Misrimal Navajee Munoth Jain Engineering College, Chennai. QCFI – Chennai Chapter focuses on promoting and implementing quality concepts within various industries and sectors in the Chennai region. This MOU aims to inculcate the quality concepts and shop floor practice for the young budding engineers. Its objective is to handhold faculty and students to run the quality circle by promoting commercialization of patents with industries, facilitate technology transfer with industries and organise QCFI conclave jointly.
