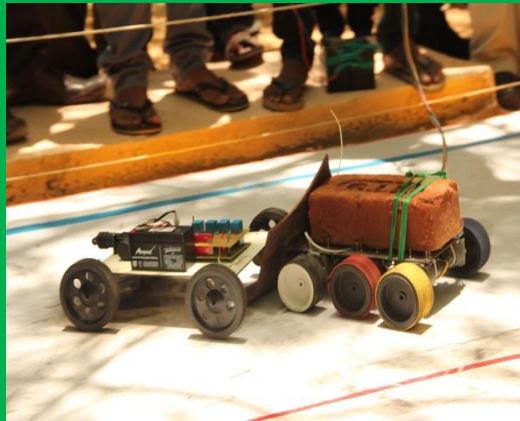

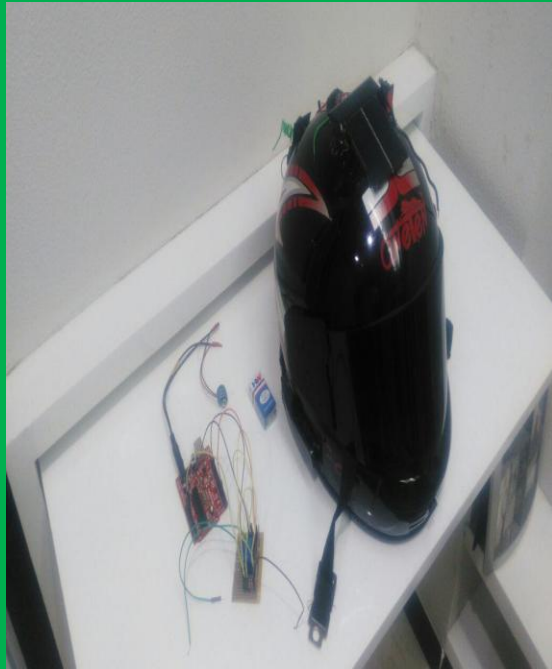

Chennai Boys 'Invent' Smart Helmet to Curb Drunk Driving

Madurai: Two students from the Mechanical Engineering department of the MNM Jain Engineering College, Chennai, won the first prize at a contest for their 'Smart Helmet' that will not allow a motorbike to start if the rider is drunk.

Abhishek N Chatrani and Nitin Sharma M, final year students, showcased their prize winning 'Smart Helmet' at the sixth State Level Mini-Project Contest organised by the Mechanical Engineering Department of the Velammal College of Engineering and Technology (VCET) in Madurai, on Friday.

Talking about the idea behind the unique helmet, Abhishek said, "In 98 percent of motorbike accident cases, the riders are killed because they do not wear helmets. Also, a prime reason for accidents is riding in a drunken state, where innocent people on the road are affected. These factors inspired us to create a special helmet that will prevent people from riding when in a drunken state."

Explaining how the helmet works, Nitin said, "A sensor fixed inside the helmet is connected to a microcontroller, which is attached to the ignition switch. The system operates on a battery attached to the helmet, which

has a back-up time of nearly eight hours. The battery can be charged with the help of a small solar panel attached to the helmet."

Nitin added that a Bluetooth headset attached to the helmet could help riders to avoid reaching for their mobile phones.

"The entire system looks big; we are working on making it smaller. We are also contemplating adding an indicator system that will work with the helmet," said the students.

Nearly 60 projects by students from different colleges across the state were displayed at the contest.

Abhishek and Nitin received a cash prize of ₹10,000. The second prize of ₹5,000 in cash was given to the team that created a 'Foot Operated Vehicle for A Physically Challenged Person'. The third prize of ₹3,000 was given to the students who created an 'Emergency Window Opening System'.

The Assistant General Manager of J. K. Fenner (India) Limited, Madurai G. Rajasekar, and MD of Infinity Engineering, Hosur, M Raj Agnesh, inaugurated the contest. The principal of VCET, N. Suresh Kumar, Head of the Mechanical Department G. Manikandan, and Assistant Professor M. Saravana Mohan were present.
